• All six conference teams will take the ice in Big Ten action this weekend, with three of the top four teams in the standings hitting the road for Friday-Saturday series. No. 7/7 Minnesota enters the weekend tied for first place as it hosts No. 6/4 Penn State, which sits two points behind the Gophers and Badgers. The Gophers are tied atop the Big Ten standings with No. 18/- Wisconsin, which visits Michigan State this weekend. No. 11/11 Ohio State sits seven points behind the Gophers and Badgers in fourth place and travels to Ann Arbor to take on Michigan.

• Wisconsin defeated Ohio State in overtime last Saturday in the nightcap of the second-annual "Super Saturday - College Hoops & Hockey" doubleheader at Madison Square Garden in New York City. The Badgers (13-8-1, 6-2-0-0 Big Ten) won their third consecutive game against a top-10 team as head coach Tony Granato returned to the World's Most Famous Arena, where he started his 14-year NHL playing career with the New York Rangers.

• The Wisconsin goaltending tandem of Jack Berry and Matt Jurusik has been equally impressive since the start of January, as the pair tops the Big Ten in goals-against average over that stretch. Jurusik paced all conference goalies with a 1.97 GAA in January, while Berry followed closely behind at 1.98. Berry held a slight advantage in save percentage at .935 compared to Jurusik's mark of .932. Both helped the Badgers post a record of 5-1-0 in January.

• With three assists in the series against Wisconsin, Ohio State sophomore Mason Jobst extended his point streak to 10 games. During that stretch, Jobst has tallied seven goals and 12 assists for a total of 19 points, more than any other player in the Big Ten over that span.

• All of this weekend's games will be available nationwide via the web, smartphones, tablets and connected devices on BTN2Go, BTN's digital extension, or BTN Plus. Full broadcast details can be found in the right column.

• Four of the top six offenses in the country reside in the Big Ten. Penn State leads the nation with 4.41 goals per game, followed closely by Ohio State in second at 4.00 goals per contest. Minnesota is fifth with 3.72 goals per outing, while Wisconsin is sixth with 3.59 goals per game.

• The Nittany Lions lead the nation in per game scoring by defensemen this season. Penn State blueliners pace all defensive units with 0.91 goals per game, 2.59 assists per contest and 3.50 points per outing. Only two other schools in the nation average more than 3.00 points per game from their defensemen (St. Lawrence and Quinnipiac).

• After leading the nation in shots on goal per game in each of the last two seasons, Penn State continues to pace all teams with 48.18 this season. The Nittany Lions also hold the national lead in shots on goal margin per game, firing 22.77 more shots on the opponents' goal than they allow. Wisconsin ranks third nationally with 35.36 shots per game and fourth in the country with a margin of +8.91 shots per contest.

• Tickets for the 2017 Big Ten Men's Ice Hockey Tournament, to be held Thursday – Saturday, March 16-18, are currently on sale. The fourth annual Big Ten Tournament will feature all six conference teams in a single-elimination format and will consist of five games that will be covered live nationally by BTN. 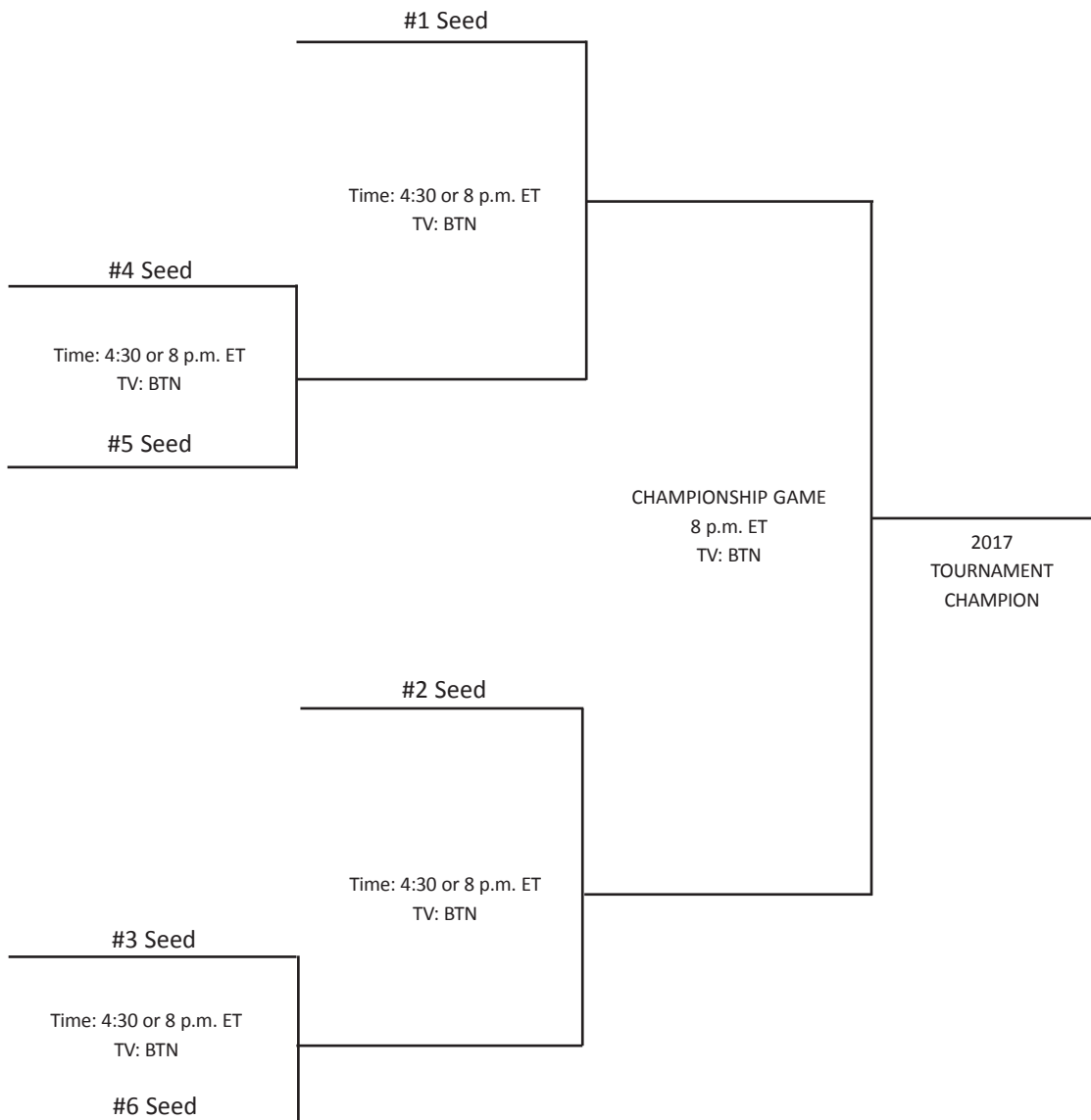
